I’ve always wanted to learn how to play the cello. But I’ve never found the time to enroll in a class. Or, perhaps more accurately, I haven’t made the time for it. Life is short, and we often feel the pressure to make the most of our time on Earth before it slips away. But what does that really mean? As King Solomon contemplated the meaning of life, he offered two recommendations.
