FIVE-FINGER PRAYERS

Prayer is a conversation with God, not a formula. Yet sometimes we might need to use a “method” to freshen up our prayer time. We can pray the Psalms or other Scriptures (such as The Lord’s Prayer), or use the ACTS method (Adoration, Confession, Thanksgiving, and Supplication). I recently came across this “Five-Finger Prayer” to use as a guide when praying for others:

- When you fold your hands, the thumb is nearest you. So begin by praying for those closest to you—your loved ones (Phil. 1:3–5).
- The index finger is the pointer. Pray for those who teach—Bible teachers and preachers, and those who teach children (1 Thess. 5:25).
- The next finger is the tallest. It reminds you to pray for those in authority over you—national and local leaders, and your supervisor at work (1 Tim. 2:1–2).
- The fourth finger is usually the weakest. Pray for those who are in trouble or who are suffering (James 5:13–16).
- Then comes your little finger. It reminds you of your smallness in relation to God’s greatness. Ask Him to supply your needs (Phil. 4:6, 19).

Whatever method you use, just talk with your Father. He wants to hear what’s on your heart.

MISSIONARIES TO BRAZIL

God called the Johnson's as missionaries to Brazil while visiting one of their missionaries in 2013. At the time Leland was pastoring the Berean Baptist Church in Shelby, North Carolina.

God allowed Leland to grow up in a Christian home. He was saved at an early age, but could not remember for sure, so at fifteen years old he got things settled. He was called to preach at a youth conference at Gospel Light Baptist Church and graduated from Atlantic Baptist Bible College and later earned a Master's Degree in Biblical Studies from Piedmont Baptist Graduate School.

God also allowed Naomi to grow up in a Christian home and was saved at a young age. While she was in high-school she had plans to become a doctor and was accepted into John's Hopkins, but felt the Lord leading her in a different direction. She surrendered her life to Him and attended Pensacola Christian College.

Many people do not know that Brazil, not the United States, has the largest population of people of African descent outside of Africa, yet has no African-American church planters. The Johnson's believe that God has called them to reach the people of Brazil.

"Our goal is to follow Paul's plan in planting pastors and churches. Paul started the church at Thessalonica in only three weeks. He was able to do this because he had the right approach. Planting and growing men to do the work of the ministry was a priority for Paul, and it will be a priority for us as well. Please pray that God would use us in a special way among the people of Brazil."

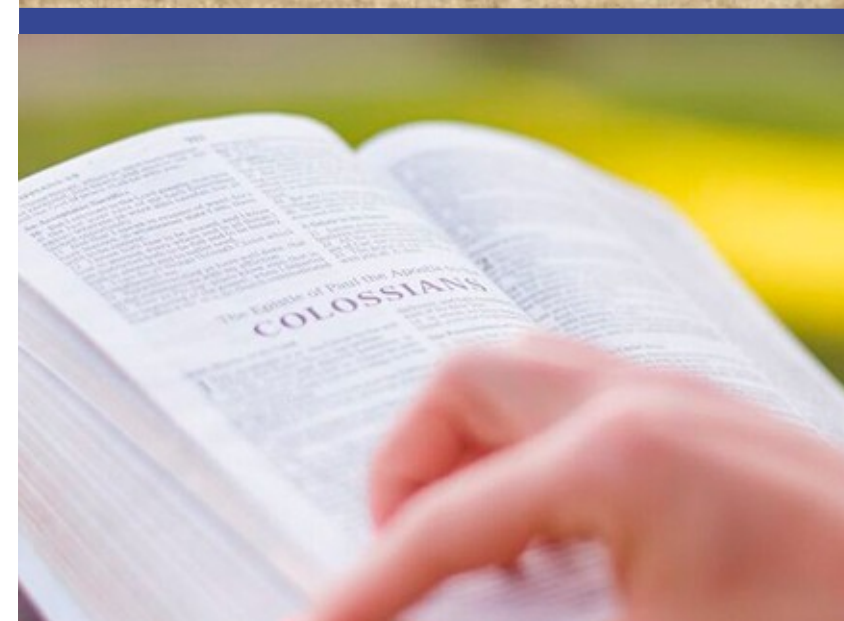
