

Josiah became a king when he was 8 years old, a seeker at 16, a reformer at 20, and a humble servant of God at age 26. His dramatic spiritual growth and leadership resulted from listening to God's Word and then obeying what he heard. While the temple in Jerusalem was being repaired and purified, the long-neglected Book of the Law was found and read aloud to young King Josiah. When he heard it, he humbled himself, tore his robes, and wept in the presence of God (2 Chronicles 34:19,27). Josiah realized the enormous sin of those who had led the nation before him, and he decided that deep and lasting change had to begin with him. His public renewal of the covenant and His commitment to follow the Lord and keep His commands ignited a revival that swept the entire nation (vv.31-33).

What's wrong with the nation where you live today? Greed? Violence? Indifference toward God? How long has it been sinking into a moral and spiritual quagmire? Are you feeling too young, or too old, or too powerless to do anything about it?

Josiah—seeker, reformer, servant of God, a 20-something king who wept for his people—has shown us the way.

Lord, send a revival, and let it begin in me.



MISSIONARY OF THE WEEK

In 1986, God called me and my family to be missionaries to the Philippines. We started 2 churches and a Bible College during our time there. Twenty-two churches have been started as a result and graduates from the Bible College continue to plant more churches. Then the Lord lead us to Mexico where we worked with a missionary and started a printing ministry. The Lord showed us the tremendous need for church planting materials in other countries. Because of health reasons, we could no longer live on the foreign field, so the Lord directed me to start *DirectLine Ministry* in 1999.

We began making trips to Mexico in a van and two-stall horse trailer. We would pack it full of donated materials for missionaries. As the ministry grew, we rented 7 storage units to hold all the donated goods and the Lord opened the doors for us to expand into different countries. We also constructed a 40x80ft warehouse.

DirectLine Ministry now has several teams and has sent thousands of Bibles and materials to 20 different countries including: the Philippines, Mexico, Honduras, remote Islands in the Bahamas, Haiti, the Dominican Republic, parts of Africa, India, and Chile. The Christmas Joy Gift Bags...We work with Independent Baptist churches, Christian schools, and orphanages in Mexico, Honduras, the Bahamas, Chile, the Philippines, Haiti, the Dominican Republic, India, Romania, Grenada, El Salvador, and Guinea-Bissau (Africa). We will add other countries as God opens the door. A Gospel tract or Scripture booklet is added to every bag. So many children have been saved as a result. It is amazing to see their faces as they receive the gifts. For most, it is the only present they will receive. This project is just a creative tool to give out the Word of God and see souls saved.
