A MAN IN HELL

Luke 16:19-31

INTRODUCTION: Noah preached judgment-the world didn't believe it, but the flood came anyway. Lot preached judgment—the y didn't believe it, but God rained hell out of heaven and destroyed Sodom anyway. And whether men believe it or not, the Lord Jesus talked about a place of torment for the unsaved.

I. His Description—Verses 19-29.

- A. He was religious—verses 24-28.
- 1. In verse 24, he prayed for mercy.
- 2. In verse 24, he prayed for water .
- 3. In verse 28, he prayed for his brothers.

Here was a man that knew how to pray . He knew th e Scriptures . He talked about Moses and the prophets , but he still went to hell .

- B. He was rich—verse 19.
- 1. Clothed in purple-imported garments from Egypt.
- 2. Clothed in fine linen—imported garments from Syria .
- 3. But underneath his fine clothes was a heart as black as hell itself.

(Man looketh upon the outward appearance.)

C. He was ruined—verse 23. That night, someone else took over his wealth, and the rich man became a beggar in hell.

Ii . His Death—Verse 22.

A. His death—sudden—no hint of sickness . (Man's life is like a vapor—like a flower .)

- B. His death—separating—from hope of heaven .
- C. His death—sobering—it took hell for him to get his eyes opened.

Iii . His Distress—Verses 24-31 .

- A. From the burning—unquenchable—verse 24.
- B. From the burdens—"go tell my brother"—verse 28.
- C. From the banishment—verses 30-31.
- 1. From love .
- 2. From light.
- 3. From liberty.
