Text - Ps. 145 (3, 9, 8)

Intro. - This psalm is called "David's Psalm of praise."
It is the only one so named and is a psalm
of pure worship.

- If it is true "that all good things must end", then
this psalm is a fitting end to the main body of the Psalms.
(The last 5 - 146, 147, 148, 149, 150 - not sure who wrote them)

So, David - sweet psalmist of Israel (all start with "Praise ye the Lord")
- Israel's greatest King (Sovereign)
- slayer of Goliath

"PERSONAL" praise
- the only psalm titled David's praise
- 88 times his name is found in Psalms
- "man of God's own heart"
- Shepherd to his sheep
- is full of PRAISE - He praised when he felt like it ✓
He praised when he didn't ✓

WHAT is he praising God for?? Blessing
"God is great, God is good..."

1 - God's Greatness - vs. 1-6 (vs. 3)

* He praises Thoroughly - "every day" / "for ever"
* He praises Theme-matically - Just like we have "church themes"

"GREAT" } our
"AWESOME" } God

2 - God's Goodness - vs. 7-10 (vs. 9)

* Morally - we ain't but HE is
* Meritfully - vs. 8 - "mercy" - NOT getting what we deserve
* Memory - vs. 7 - memories of how the Lord was good to you!

3 - God's GRACE - vs. 18-21 (vs. 8)

* Reviewed - vs. 18-20a - look back at His Grace thru our lives

* Response - vs. 20-21 - His grace creates a response
in those we
