3- LET - vs. 4 - "God cannot build our character w/o our COOPERATION" - Wiersbe
"perfect work" * finished product, not sinless perfection
* no half-way job

* complete work of developing maturity - from babe to young man to father - ISRAEL
"weary nothing" - lacking nothing, a complete believer w/a SUBMISSIVE WILL

4- ASK - vs. 5/b - cp. ch. 4:1-3 and ch. 5:13-18, these folks had trouble w/ praying right

↳ WHAT? WISDOM
↳ HOW? IN FAITH - "double-minded" (NOT)

- Final Result - vs. 12 - BLESSED - HAPPY! Confident settled satisfied

Text - James 1:1-12

Intro. - "Ready, Set, Go" - what I've heard that THEN, about the time someone is clearly beaten in a race, someone, usually the one losing, yells, "Wait, I wasn't ready."

- NOT Ready, NOT Prepared - Do OVER, can we start over - "I WASN'T READY"
