Text - Isa. 57:15

Intro. - There is perhaps no greater prophet of the OT than Isaiah. His name means "Jehovah is Salvation".

- He is the greatest of the "writing" prophets.

- He is quoted more in the NT than all other prophets combined. (over 85 times)

- Prophesied primarily to Judah; ministered for 50+ yrs.

- His life spanned the reigns of 4 kings of Judah: Uzziah, Jotham

* - His writings picture the Lord: *Lifted on the Throne ch 63 Ahaz

*Lifted on the Cross ch 53 Hezekiah

* - His favorite name for the Lord is the (Isa. 53)

"Holy One of Israel!" (25 times)

- His book much like the Bible itself:

• Sacrifice on Calvary - 53:1-6

• Future Kingdom - 59:20/60:18/21

Divine Order
of Things

1st ~ God's Holiness
2nd ~ Our Humility
3rd ~ "To Revive"
