WHY ARE THERE FOUR GOSPEL RECORDS?

1. To provide a _____ view of Christ

◆ These four records are four portraits of the Messiah. Together they give us a complete view and a full description of our Lord.

2. To communicate the gospel message to different _____

◆ In the days of Christ, there were three main cultural groups - Jews, Greeks, and Romans. Each of these groups are specifically targeted in the Gospel Records, because all men need to hear the gospel.

3. To _____ the gospel message

◆ A message of such importance as the gospel is confirmed with four independent witnesses who all verified the same truths without contradiction.

4. To _____ and complete the record of Christ

- ◆ Though each book can stand alone as a valid record, taken together they clarify and complete one another. Some books include details about persons and events that other books do not.

5. To provide a large quantity of _____ concerning Christ

◆ If the story of Jesus Christ is the central message of all the Bible - and it is - then it is reasonable to understand that the Lord would give us a large portion of Scripture concerning Christ and His work.

◆ One account of Christ would have been much shorter, but God intended to emphasize the gospel message in His Word by giving so much Scripture to deal with it.
